St. Louis Children's Hospital Child Development Center Program and Philosophy

Our child development centers are committed to providing quality care and educational programs for children of BJC HealthCare and WashU Medicine employees. We offer a developmentally appropriate play-based curriculum in a warm, nurturing environment. We provide a variety of learning experiences to promote individual growth and development for children between the ages of 6 weeks old to 6 years old.

Programs include:

Infant/Toddler Care

• Early Preschool: 2–3 years old

• Preschool: 3–4 years old

• Pre-Kindergarten: 4–5 years old

• Per diem care: 2 years old and older (pending space availability)

Full-time, regular part-time, and variable part-time scheduling is offered year-round to help meet your family's child care needs. Our hours (site specific) range from 5:45 a.m. until 6 p.m. with extended care offered daily until 8 p.m. Tuition is based on the number of days your child is contracted.

Our centers are licensed through the State of Missouri, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Office of Childhood, Child Care Compliance and Regulation. A strong partnership between the family, the child development center, and the community can help provide a solid start to your child's future.

Waiting List Process

Thank you for your interest in St. Louis Children's Hospital's Child Development Centers. Below is information to help you understand how the waiting list process works. The waiting list is shared by both the Taylor and Newstead Avenue centers.

- Waiting list application is completed and turned in (if expecting, please turn in the Update Instructions sheet after the child is born).
- You will be placed on the waiting list according to your **application date**.
- When a spot opens for your child, you will be notified and have the choice to schedule a tour or remain on the list. After the tour, you will have 48 hours to accept or decline the space. If we do not hear from you within 48 hours, we will offer the space to the next applicant.
- Once you accept the position, you have five working days to return the Enrollment Form, Enrollment Status Contract, and tuition deposit to secure your space.
- Placing your name on the waiting list, or updating information for a newborn, does not guarantee placement on desired entry date and center location preference.

There is no way of knowing how long the wait will be, as we do not know when families will be leaving. Occasionally, we will have openings throughout the year. Most openings occur for both centers in mid-August, when many children transition to the next age-appropriate classroom.
