olleen Wilkerson exudes an aura of confidence and calm. Spend just a few moments with her and you'll sense she's someone you'd want by your side in trying times. The kind of person you could trust to make sure – despite whatever difficulty, emotions or chaos you were dealing with – that you were going to get through it and that everything was going to be just fine. And that's a good thing, because at Christian Hospital, that's a big part of her job.

"This hospital is essential to this community, in terms of providing care, but more than that, Christian is my home. I just knew the first moment I walked in for my first interview that this is where I belonged."

Colleen smiles at the memory. That's not unusual, because she smiles a lot. But then, as a thought occurs to her, she turns serious. "In the years since, I guess I've been trying to make everyone else who walks in feel that same sense of being home. That this is their hospital, and that they're considered family and special and cared for."

Our patients are like family and Colleen knows the importance of listening to their stories. She is assisting the foundation through the Heart of a Hero program by asking patients to share their stories. The stories that make them laugh and cry. Each one is just as important and to Colleen it is like listening to family.

Being on the Forefront of the Patient Experience

Her passion for nurturing a caring and respectful patient experience goes deeper

than providing inspired management for key staff. Colleen also places herself on the front lines every day, working directly to solve patient problems and address whatever stress or difficulties their families may experience.

"Our Emergency Department is open 24/7, and so patient family service can't stop just because the sun goes down," she says. "If people have problems, I want to be there for them. That's why I often give my personal cell phone out, because if I've been working with a family about their concern, I want them to know that just because it's Friday and the weekend's coming doesn't mean I'm not still available to help them."

A Holistic Approach to Excellence

While Colleen's role and personal dedication to the patient experience is a powerful example, they're part of a larger story – an institutional commitment to reaching out to the community and nurturing patient satisfaction.

Upon discharge, the foundation makes contact with patients to learn more about their experience. In many situations, when patients have a good experience at Christian Hospital, they respond by becoming a part of our grateful patient program, Heart of a Hero. Patients have the chance to thank the employee(s) who went the extra mile, like Colleen, to ensure their stay makes a difference for future patients and continues to make Christian Hospital the community's hospital of choice.



hristian Hospital has received multiple awards throughout the years, but the recognition that means the most to us comes from our patients and their families, leading to the **Heart of a Hero** program. The Christian Hospital Foundation began this fundraising program in the summer of 2013 as an opportunity for patients to recognize and thank our staff and physicians throughout the hospital who provided exceptional care.

he *Advanced Technology*, *Compassionate Care* campaign has truly become the brickwork of our foundation over the last year. We are pleased to share the advancements from 2013.

Not only were we successful in raising additional funds, we created lasting relationships with community members, employees and


