The Hybrid Room preserves our leadership role as a "heart hospital" in Saint Louis.

The Legacy Prints Artwork Program continues to enhance the walls of renovated areas of Christian Hospital with scenic images to provide therapeutic support for patients and guests. These areas include the ground, main, 4th and 5th floors, and the Courtyard Café.

Through community benefit programs, the foundation provides free education and screening events. More than 11,000 community members improved their health by participating in weight loss programs, a heart fair, an orthopedic services fair, a cancer awareness program and receiving screening mammograms.

The foundation also secured funds on behalf of the Community Health Access Program (CHAP) to successfully help approximately 4,000 non-emergent patients access affordable sources of care using an innovative approach to address needs of the whole person and strengthen their connection to community support systems.

We hope you enjoy reviewing our 2016 annual report with highlights of our efforts to provide vital support to Christian Hospital and recognition of our generous donors.

HEART OF A HERO RECIPIENT





A healed heart

The first transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) performed in the Christian Hospital hybrid room

In January of 2016, Lily Hughes, 73, knew something was wrong. She was experiencing fatigue and had severe difficulty breathing.

"I was always tired, even though I slept all the time. I would wake up, do a few things and I would be tired right away again," says Hughes.

After a consultation with her primary care physician, it became clear it was a problem with Hughes' heart. She was referred to Christian Hospital for further treatment.

After an extensive evaluation, the cardiology team at CH determined Hughes had severe aortic valve stenosis, and needed her aortic valve replaced. When the aortic valve is damaged, it doesn't allow the heart to adequately force blood to flow to vital organs. The traditional treatment replaces the diseased valve by means of open-heart surgery. However, with Hughes' extensive medical history, including a major stroke, it was too risky to perform. Her only option was an advanced procedure called transcatheter aortic valve replacement, or TAVR. TAVR is currently only offered to high-risk patients, and Hughes fit the criteria.

TAVR is performed in a hybrid room, which combines the equipment of an operating room, procedures of a cardiac catheterization lab and advanced medical imaging technology in one space. These specialized rooms are only available in about 2 percent of hospitals across the country. CH opened its hybrid room in 2015, the only of its kind in north St. Louis County.

"The hybrid room allows us to provide care for our patients in a way we previously could not. Before, Christian Hospital could only offer traditional surgical treatment options for valve replacements. Having this technology has opened up a highway of possibilities and revolutionizes the way we treat multiple cardiac and vascular conditions," says Stefano Schena, MD, a Washington University cardiothoracic surgeon who practices exclusively at Christian Hospital.

"It was scary to be the first," she says. "But I had comfort knowing I was in good hands."

Hughes' need for TAVR arose around the same time the hybrid room became equipped to perform the procedure. She was the first patient to receive the procedure at the hospital. "It was scary to be the first," she says. "But I had comfort knowing I was in good hands." And she was. CH has a dedicated heart and valve team, who have obtained additional credentials and specialized training in TAVR.

Hughes woke up shortly after her procedure, able to breathe strongly and clearly — something she hadn't experienced in a long time. She recovered



in the hospital for only three days before returning to her home in Alton, Illinois.

Five months after the procedure, Hughes feels like herself again. "Now I'm awake and energetic, and I can do things I like to do again," she says. She enjoys spending more time with her five children and watching her grandchildren play.

Since Hughes' case, multiple successful TAVRs have been performed in the hybrid room. "It's an ongoing effort at Christian Hospital to provide world-class care to more patients with a greater diversity of needs. Since the opening of the hybrid room, we are constantly working to bring more extensive, innovative treatment options to our patients," says Dr. Schena. "The TAVR procedure is only the first step."

► WHAT IS TAVR?

Transcatheter aortic valve replacement, or TAVR, is a minimally invasive procedure to replace the aortic valve of the heart. It is performed by threading the new valve via a catheter through the groin. A balloon expands the replacement valve within the damaged valve, allowing it to begin immediate, healthy function.

The Hybrid Room

The hybrid room is a \$5.5 million modern facility that allows Christian Hospital to perform advanced cardiac therapies. Funding for the hybrid room was primarily raised by the Christian Hospital Foundation, which received donations from Christian Hospital physicians, staff and the community.

Christian Hospital's heart and vascular experts are an integrated team of specialists with advanced training in a variety of heart treatments, with services that range from traditional surgery to minimally invasive procedures.

COMMUNITY HEALTH ACCESS PROGRAM

CHAP receives three grants from community partners to help expand the program, ensuring more patients receive access to care in the most appropriate setting.



\$95,000 from Christian Hospital Foundation

CHAP has received this grant to help fund equipment and supply purchases for patient home visits and community events.

\$100,000 from Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals

North County Incorporated has received this grant to help fund the CHAP for Christian Hospital and SSM Health DePaul Hospital.

\$175,000 from Express Scripts

CHAP and Memory Care Home Solutions have received this grant to fund a pilot program that will enhance the health of seniors with dementia and their family caregivers.

With CHAP, advanced practice paramedics identify people who are overutilizing emergency medical services for non-emergencies (more than three-to-five times a month). Then, when a known high utilizer calls 911 or comes to the ED, CHAP resource coordinators can assess and connect the individual with the help they need.

"Our shared goal is to put medicine within reach of people who need it, and to do so, we must address the underlying social, economic and health-related conditions that hold us back," says Susan Stith, Vice President, Diversity & Inclusion, and Corporate Giving, Express Scripts. "We proudly support the innovative work of Christian Hospital and Memory Care Solutions, and look forward to improving access to care for people in the North County area."

Since its inception, CHAP at Christian Hospital has positively impacted more than 10,000 people.

"North County Inc. is pleased to serve as a conduit for collaboration with one of North County's major corporations, Mallinckrodt and top health care providers, Christian Hospital and SSM Health DePaul Hospital," said Rebecca Zoll, president and CEO of North County Inc. "This initiative is important

because it connects our community's highest at-risk residents with access to preventive and wrap-around services that will improve their health and overall quality of life."

The grant will help Christian Hospital expand CHAP to ensure more patients receive access to care in the most appropriate setting. "We are thankful that Mallinckrodt recognizes our approach to provide measurable and positive outcomes in low-income populations and is willing to help us refine the program and broaden its access so that more patients can benefit," said Ron McMullen, then president of Christian Hospital.

For SSM Health DePaul Hospital, this grant will enable the hospital to work with community ambulance services to develop a model to test the effectiveness of CHAP in its service area.

Unlike any other organization, Christian Hospital is coordinating efforts of both EMS and the Emergency Department to re-navigate non-emergent patients to receive care in a more appropriate setting.

2016 COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

CHAP received the 2016 Community Service Award from the Missouri Emergency Medical Services Association (MEMSA) to recognize the hospital's CHAP team for making north St. Louis County a better place to live through their hard work and dedication to the overall improvement of the community's health. The award was presented July 27 at the MESMA annual meeting in Branson, Missouri.

"We take a holistic approach with our patients to ensure not only their medical needs are met, but also their daily living needs such as food, shelter, transportation and more," says Shannon Watson, APP, CHAP community health supervisor. "Our focus is helping people navigate through the health care system, improve population health and the overall experience of receiving care. Among the 150 patients identified as high utilizers and enrolled in CHAP, we had a 63 percent reduction in emergency utilization and a 54 percent decrease in admissions. We're honored and humbled to be recognized statewide by MEMSA as a program that is really making a difference to fill those gaps in health care and create a healthier community."

BRINGING MEDICAL CARE TO YOUR DOOR



Bobbie Austin of Florissant, Missouri is 70 years old and has Type 2 Diabetes and breathing problems, preventing her from leaving her home for medical care. However, Austin recently started taking part in Christian Hospital's telemedicine program, CHAP. Using a tablet, she can communicate with a doctor at the hospital, and guide a paramedic through a thorough examination. Instead of going to the doctor several times a month, the care comes to Austin.

"When I looked at them,
I just said, 'Oh my God,
help is here.' It's great,"
said Austin, "and I thank
God for them."

"What we do here, trying to keep patients out of the hospital, is really increase their quality of life. If patients are constantly in and out of the hospital, they just get sicker and sicker, and that's no way to live," said Shannon Watson, Community Health Supervisor for Christian Hospital EMS.
